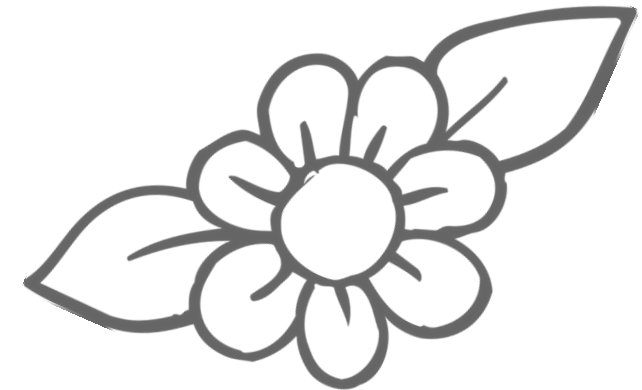

# APRIL HIGHLIGHTS



**Film Noir Lecture Series | 4/4-5/9 6:30-8:00** Film noir defined a short-lived moment of Hollywood films. While most of these films were B movies at the time, the sharp eyes of French critics who saw them after WWII helped crystalize the stylistic elements that pushed them to become part of one of the most recognizable American film genres. Presented by Dr. Anthony Hayt, this 6-week course, will explore the defining aspects of film noir including its stylistic roots in German Expressionism; its thematic roots in American hardboiled fiction of the 20s, 30s, and 40s; and its legacy throughout the last 70 years. We'll be watching and discussing: *Double Indemnity* (1944), *Sunset Boulevard* (1950), *Chinatown* (1974), *Blade Runner* (1982), and *Blue Velvet* (1986) all on the library's newly installed top-notch AV equipment.

**Yin Restorative Yoga | 4/9 6:30-8:00** A gentle, passive class designed to allow relaxation and focus on the breath and body. Postures are on the floor, either seated or supine, and held for two to five minutes, allowing a focus on the connective tissue around the joints. Please bring a blanket or yoga mat and if you have other props you'd like to bring along (like a bolster, pillows or blocks) feel free. No prior yoga experience is necessary and this is a 1-time class so it's a great chance to explore if this type of gentle yoga is for you!

**Music Sundays with Appalasia | 4/15 2:00-3:00** The band was formed by Mimi Jong, Jeff Berman, and Sue Powers and together they have created an evocative and ambitious performance language for dulcimer, erhu, banjo, and vocals that combines the influence of their folk-roots with original composition and inspired improvisation. The individual members each have extensive histories of collaboration, performing, and recording with artists including Tony Trischka, Pasang Dolma, Alash, Susan Mckeown, Karen Han, Min Xiao Fen, Samir Chatterjee, Osei Koranke, Devilish Merry, and Huang Xiang, to name just a few.
