A graphic novel adventure about a girl who discovers roller derby right as she and her best friend are growing apart.

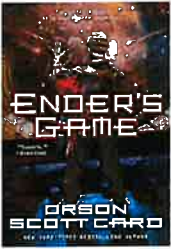
